4K-3rd Grade Format:

- Play 4 v 4
- Size 3 ball
- 4 quarters, 8 minutes each quarter
- No Goalkeeper, Offside, or Referees
- Field Size: 25 x 35 (width x length)
- Goal Size: 4' x 6' (width x length)
- All players should receive 50% playing time
- Substitutions occur every half quarter
- Maximum Rosters: 8

4th-5th Grade Format:

- Play 7 v 7
- Size 4 ball
- 2 halves, 25 minutes each half
- Goalkeeper, Offside, Referees, and Build Out Line
- Field Size: 45 x 65 yards (width x length)
- Goal Size: 6.5' x 18.5' (width x length)
- All players should receive 50% playing time
- Substitutions are unlimited and can occur anytime
- Maximum Rosters: 14

6th-8th Grade Format:

- Play 9 v 9
- Size 4 ball
- 2 halves, 25 minutes each half
- Goalkeeper, Offside, Referees, and Build Out Line
- Field Size: 55 x 80 yards (width x length)
- Goal Size: 7' x 21' (width x length)
- All players should receive 50% playing time
- Substitutions are unlimited and can occur anytime
- Maximum Rosters: 16

BE A VOLUNTEER COACH

Quality coaching is the backbone of any successful youth sports program. Each team will need 2-3 volunteers to help run practice drills and keep games running smoothly. WAWM RCS staff will be onsite to provide assistance and support during all practices and games. Coaches will receive a season guide complete with weekly practice plans. A preseason coaching clinic will introduce coaches to what skills should be taught and demonstrations of how to teach each skill.

Team Formation: 4K-1st grade teams are co-ed, separated by grade and formed by school. Roster sizes will be intentionally kept small to improve game play, allow for players to be more active in the field, and allow coaches to provide more attention to each player. 2nd-8th grade teams will be separated by gender, grade, and school. Roster sizes are intentionally kept small to improve game play, allow for players to be more active in the field.

Volunteer Coaches: 1-2 coaches are needed for each team. WAWM RCS staff will be on site and provide weekly practice plans and help setup equipment. Coaches will teach weekly drills in practice and help on game days.

Coach Clinics: WAWM RCS will provide a coaching clinic. Parents interested in volunteering must attend the clinic. Clinic will consist of demonstrations of how to teach each primary skill, drills associated with each skill, and share our league philosophy and core values to ensure all participants have a consistent and high quality experience.

Equipment: T-shirt will be provided to all participants. Cleats and shin guards are highly recommended. All other equipment will be provided.
