### Flag Football Information 2022

We are pleased to have your child participating in our flag football program. The season is scheduled to start the week of August 15 – Saturday, October 22. During the season our website will also have information posted in regards to practices, game schedules, etc.

#### General

- · Fee: \$35 Resident/\$53 non-resident. Fees will increase \$10 after the registration deadline of Monday, August 1, 5pm.
- · League consists of seven (7) games.
- · Games are played on Saturday mornings at West Allis Athletic Complex on the baseball fields closest to Cleveland Ave.
- · Game times range from 9am-3pm, varying each week depending on schedule.
- · Games are played rain or shine.

#### **Team Formation**

Teams are formed randomly each season. Teams are formed by grade and by school in the order players are registered. The maximum number of players per team is 10. Schools that have more than 10 players will be divided into two teams. Schools with less than 10 will be combined with another school. Players registering after the deadline will be placed on a team that has an opening. The WAWM RCS Department reserves the right to adapt team formation to best suit the needs of the program.

### **Concussion Information, Code of Conduct & Background Checks**

- · All coaches, parents and athletes are required to electronically sign a Code of Conduct and a Concussion Awareness form.
- · All head and assistant coaches will be screened for a criminal background check.
- Detailed instructions on how to complete these requirements will be presented at the coaches' meeting. All of the above requirements must be completed prior to participation.

## Coaches' Responsibilities

- · Coaches are required to attend a mandatory coaches clinic prior to the season at Franklin Field house.
  - Grades 2-3: Wednesday, August 10, 6-7pm
  - Grades 4-8: Wednesday, August 10, 7-8pm
- $\cdot$  At the meeting the following will take place: receive player roster, league rules, select practice time, questions/other trainings
- Must be present at practices and games or arrange for a suitable replacement.
